## Notes for the reading of S.LUKE's Passion

1. **There are no responses.** Candles & incense are not used.
2. **Standing for the Passion remains THE sign of respect.** *Those who find it difficult to stand for long periods* should *SIT* at the beginning *STANDING* for the most significant part of the passion – which begins with the words:  
*'As they were leading him away....'*
3. **ALL GENUFLECT** and pray silently at the words:  
*'With these words He breathed his last.'*
